### Manuscript Submission Guide

*Journal's Purpose:* The *Taiwan Journal of Democracy* (TJD) is a refereed journal devoted to the study of democratic politics, in general, and the development of new democracies, in particular. Published biannually, the journal's goal is to provide an open forum, free of cultural and partisan biases, for academic research and a venue for dialogue among scholars and professional specialists concerning democratic experience.

*Article Submission:* The editors welcome manuscripts based on original research, which may include significant reexamination of existing literature. All manuscripts submitted to the TJD should not have been published elsewhere, in any form, and should not be under review by other publications. Manuscript length should be in the range of nine thousand words, footnotes included. The main text should be single-spaced. Citations should be single-spaced, consecutively numbered, and placed at the bottom of the page. They should follow the style recommended in *The Chicago Manual of Style*, 16<sup>th</sup> ed. (Chicago: University of Chicago Press, 2010). Electronic submission of articles via email attachment in Word is required. Articles with tables and figures must be submitted in both Word and PDF format.

*Honorarium:* The *Taiwan Journal of Democracy* offers a modest honorarium for each full-length essay (a smaller honorarium is provided for shorter essays). This rule does not apply to essays based on papers presented at Taiwan Foundation for Democracy-sponsored conferences and symposia.
